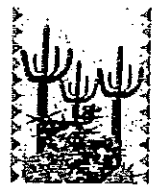


**SANTA FE, OPERA & MORE!**

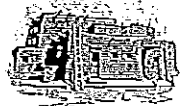

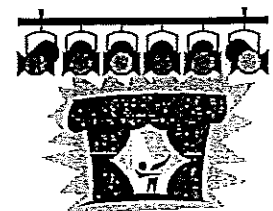
**DAY 1- SUNDAY, AUGUST 15

Visit a pueblo where contemporary artists carry on the traditional art of black on white pottery. The skills of these artisans are unparalleled.
