DAY 1- SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 12

FT. COLLINS/DENVER TO COLORADO SPRINGS

Step back in time on the **(1) Georgetown Loop**, a vintage steam train. Be amazed at this engineering marvel where the track loops back on itself to gain elevation. See one of the finest private collections of railroad equipment in the country at the **Colorado Railroad Museum** in Golden. Cap the day with dinner at *Giusseppe's Old Depot Restaurant*, the original train depot in Colorado Springs. **(D)**



DAY 2- MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 13

COLORADO SPRINGS LOCAL

Climb Colorado's most famous "14'er-" the *easy* way- on board the **(2) Pike's Peak Cog Railway**. The view from the summit is fabulous. Enjoy **lunch and a Native American Dance performance at Garden of the Gods Park Visitors Center**. Then explore the beautiful red rock formations in the park. All..aboard **(3) Cripple Creek & Victor Narrow Gauge Railroad**. Take a 45 minute trip through the mining district on 2-foot gauge track, pulled by a coal-fired steam locomotive. **(B, L)**

DAY 3- TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 14

COLORADO SPRINGS TO ALAMOSA

See Colorado's "Grand Canyon," the **Royal Gorge**, from *top to bottom!* Ride the **(4) Royal Gorge Route Train** through the depths of the gorge along the Arkansas River. (Engine Ride available at additional cost.)



Board the **(5) Royal Gorge Incline Rail** for a ride up the walls of the canyon to the top of the gorge where you enter the **Royal Gorge Bridge & Park**. Enjoy more spectacular views: Take the aerial tram across the gorge or walk the highest suspension bridge in the world. This afternoon, explore **Great Sand Dunes National Park on a dune wagon ride**. **(B, L)**

DAY 4- WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 15
ALAMOSA TO DURANGO

Allll...aboard Board the **(6) Toltec Gorge Ltd** in Alamosa for our transfer to Antonito where we board the **(7) Cumbres & Toltec Scenic Railroad**. Ride from Antonito, CO to Cumbres Pass, NM. Enjoy magnificent scenery from high desert country, through thick forests of spruce and fir, across the spectacular Toltec Gorge. Our motorcoach meets us and we travel on to Durango. **(B,L)**



DAY 5- THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 16
DURANGO TO OURAY



Take the leisurely 45-mile ride on the legendary **(8) Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railway**, following the Animas River through the San Juan National Forest. The scenery is incredible! Time on own to explore the old mining town of Silverton. Our motorcoach meets us for the drive along the spectacular **“Million Dollar Highway”** to **Ouray**, called Colorado’s “Little Switzerland.”

DAY 6- FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 17
OURAY TO GRAND JUNCTION

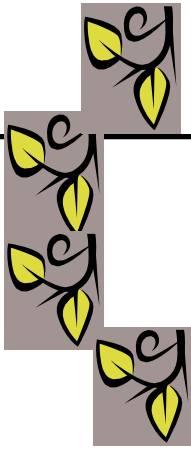
The gold rush days and mining history come alive on a **guided 4-wheel drive tour** into the San Juan mountains. The scenery is breath-taking! Visit the **Black Canyon of the Gunnison National Park**. These 2,700 foot rock walls, cut by the Gunnison River, narrow to just 40 feet by the river! This is some of the oldest rock on earth! Continue on to Grand Junction. **(B)**

DAY 7- SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 18
GRAND JUNCTION TO FT. COLLINS/DENVER

Begin the day with a **catered breakfast on Colorado National Monument**. The light reflecting off the red rocks is truly magnificent! It’s on to Leadville, the highest incorporated city in America. All...aboard the **(9) Leadville, Colorado & Southern Railroad** for a 2.5 hour narrated journey through the mining district. This is some of Colorado’s best untamed wilderness scenery. Return to Denver/Fort Collins by motorcoach. **(B, Box lunch)**

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
