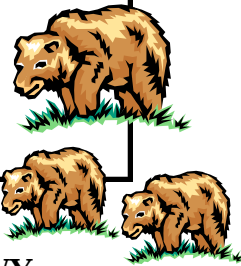

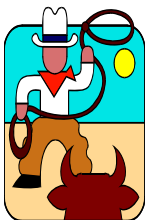

DAY 1- SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 8 FT. COLLINS TO THERMOPOLIS, WY

Travel north into the Cowboy State. Enjoy a surprise stop in Cheyenne. Continue along the old Oregon Trail to Glen Rock. Lunch together at the historic Higgins Hotel. Tour the Hot Springs State Park before checking in to our Thermopolis hotel. Enjoy evening on own. (L)

DAY 2- SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 9 THERMOPOLIS TO CODY, WY

Cody is a reminder of earlier times when Yellowstone country was truly wild and western. Discover this unique town on our trolley tour. Experience **Buffalo Bill Historical Center**. Five world class museums and a research library make up this center: *Buffalo Bill Museum, Cody Firearms Museum, Plains Indian Museum, Whitney Gallery of Western Art* and the *Draper Museum of Natural History*, featuring the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem. There's truly something for everyone. Browse at your leisure. Overnight in Cody. (CB)

DAY 3- MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 10 CODY TO THERMOPOLIS

VIA YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK

Today... *do nature* in our country's *first* national park. Keep your cameras ready: Wildlife roam freely and geothermal activity abounds. A park guide gets us "up close and personal" with this amazing area. Lunch included at the historic Lake Yellowstone Hotel. Restored to its 1920s grandeur, it's a reminder of the golden age of touring in the park- *when it was done by stage-coach*. Overnight Thermopolis. (CB, L)

DAY 4- TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 11 THERMOPOLIS TO HOME

Depart Thermopolis for home. Stop in Casper, known as the "Hub of Trails." Enjoy lunch together with a surprise activity. Return to Fort Collins. (CB, L)
